Year 2's will be learning about Mass, Capacity and Temperature, Fractions, Time, Statistics, Position and Direction and Money.</p> 	<p>In Literacy, we will be writing our own Narrative focusing on the key components we have recently learnt about. We will then begin to learn how to write a diary.</p> 	
<p>In phonics, we will continue to work through the extended code units to develop our phonics knowledge. Year 1's will be working towards the phonics screening check assessments in June.</p>	<p>In Geography, we will take part in a comparison study by looking at the similarities and differences between two places.</p> 	<p>In History, we will be learning about the space race.</p> 
<p>In DT, our learning theme will be 'investigating stitches'. The children will learn how to cross stitch and create their own pattern.</p>	<p>PE will be every Thursday afternoon during Summer 1. <p>In Science, we will continue our learning about everyday materials.
